UNIFORM CARE

DO'S

- 1. PRESOAK: If your uniform is heavily soiled or has grass/mud stains and you are not able to launder it immediately, please soak the uniform in a container of water and pre-soaking agents until you are able to launder it. Mud and grass stains will set in these uniforms.
- 2. WASHING: Do not wash the white uniform with other colors. These uniforms tend to pick up colors very easily. Please wash all pieces of the uniform in cool water with a mild detergent. If the uniform shows any discoloration after the first wash cycle, please wash the uniform again before it dries.
- 3. DRYING: Please hang the uniforms to dry whenever possible. The dryer will discolor the uniform pieces and may result in shrinkage.*

DON'TS

- 1. *If use of a dryer is necessary, please do not use high heat! The heat will soften the numbers causing them to stick to each other. Remove the uniform from the dryer immediately!
- 2. Do not use bleach. The chance of color separation and the weakening of some materials is increased with the use of bleach.
- 3. Do not wash pieces with contrast colors together.
- 4. Do not dry clean any uniform pieces.
